Scholarships

International students must demonstrate they have sufficient funds to cover living expenses, tuition, and all other expenses incurred during their stay, including roundtrip transportation. Supporting documents must be submitted prior to admission, where applicable. Living expenses are approximately \$13,000/year. Tuition fees are \$7,452 per semester, for the first three semesters of the master's program and \$6,688.80 per semester for the first six semesters of the doctoral program. Tuition fees for subsequent semesters are \$300/semester. Doctoral students receive an exemption scholarship of \$5,604.90 per semester, which is deducted from their tuition fees. A semester is four months.

General rule

- To be eligible for admission to an INRS program with a thesis or dissertation requirement, the candidate must choose and be accepted by a research director. To do this, the candidate must
 - Contact (and preferably meet in person) a research professor before submitting this admission form. To facilitate the search process, the [INRS website](#) provides a list of program directors, a list of professors and their research interests, and the addresses and phone numbers of the research centres.

- Indicate below which research professor has verbally agreed to act as the candidate's research director. Please note that the research professor's acceptance will not be official until he or she has read the "Dossier de candidature" and completed the form entitled "Acceptation motivée du directeur de recherche." These documents will be made available to research professors by the INRS registrar's office.

Special cases

- For international students applying to the *Doctorat en études urbaines* or *Maîtrise et doctorat en télécommunications* and all students applying to the *Maîtrise en études urbaines*, admissions committees will review applications without requiring proof of acceptance by a research professor. It will fall to the admissions committees to find an available professor in a relevant discipline. Students may also choose to look for a research director in advance on their own.

For postgraduate degrees in *pratiques de recherche et action publique* (1886) and the short *Mobilisation et transfert de connaissances* (0886) graduate program:

- Candidates must submit curriculum vitae to demonstrate relevant experience to support their applications.

- For the following programs— *Maîtrise en sciences expérimentales de la santé*, *Maîtrise et doctorat en virologie et immunologie*, *Maîtrise en microbiologie appliquée*, *Doctorat en biologie*, and *Maîtrise et doctorat en sciences de la terre*— describe the proposed research project agreed on with your research director (general subject, overall objectives, planned methodology, expected duration, etc.). Accepted students will be required to get a more detailed description of their research topic approved before registering for the first time.

<p>Applicants to the master's program must submit a 200–500 word cover letter describing their fields of interest and explaining why they want to pursue graduate studies in demography.</p> <p>Applicants to the doctoral program must submit a 200–500 word cover letter describing their fields of interest and explaining why they want to pursue postgraduate studies in demography, a brief 500–1,000 word outline of their research project, and a curriculum vitae. They must also include the name of their research director on the admission form. Candidates should refer to the demographics program faculty list and contact professors who supervise research in their field before applying to the doctoral program.</p>	<p>Applicants to the master's program must submit a 500–2,000 word essay describing their research interests. Although not required, candidates are encouraged to review the program faculty list and research topics covered before submitting their admission applications. Candidates are asked to contact a professor to identify a field of study and potential research director.</p> <p>Applicants to the doctoral program must submit a proposal of approximately 3,000 words for a preliminary research project in urban studies. The proposal must include the subject and framework of analysis, the potential research focus, an indication of the methodology to be used, and a bibliography.</p>	<p>Candidates must show relevant experience to support their applications by submitting curriculum vitae and cover letters demonstrating their understanding of the components and requirements of the program, specifically in terms of on-the-ground community engagement. Candidates should use the cover letters (no more than 2,000 words) to introduce themselves, explain how the program relates to their experience, and identify a scholarship topic. Candidates must be accepted by a research director. Eligible candidates may be contacted for an admission interview.</p>
